We are very pleased to announce that from August/September 2017 Butterfly Lodge Nursery will be introducing new online learning journeys.



Using a piece of educational software called 'Tapestry' every child will have their own individual learning journal. By logging on with a secure username and password you will be able to access your child's journal. Parents are only able to view their own child's journal and all information is stored on a highly secure server, which is monitored closely. We know how much your children like to bring home their work to show you. Therefore, any work to be included on their learning journal will be photographed and added with an explanation of the learning that took place. Tapestry allows you, as your child's primary educator, to add observations and photographs of your own as well as share your comments. We love to hear about learning and WOW moments from home to share with your child in nursery.
